THIRD EDITION "INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL ORVIETO-TODI"

The third edition of the "International Summer School Orvieto-Todi" will address the issues of knowledge, forecasting, prevention, protection, planning and preparation for **risk management**.

This edition, like the previous ones, will be held in English, and will see a working group of which they are part, as well as the **President of Alta Scuola** Giovanni Selli and Paola Cerchice, the Association **Lares Italia - National Union of Graduate Experts in Civil Protection** with its President, Danilo Calabrese and their experts, **the University of Blida 1** - Algeria with Prof Mourad Maroc, the **Scientific Director of the Summer School** Endro Martini.

The final programme is being defined and will be published in its advanced version in both Italian and English, together with logistical information and participation modalities with a roadmap. The first details are as follows:

Sunday, July 20 - Orvieto: arrival of the participants and reception ceremony at the Congress Hall

Monday, July 21 - Foligno: meeting at the headquarters of the Civil Protection where we will discuss the national systems of Civil Protection and management of Major Risks and the protection and enhancement of Cultural Assets.

In the afternoon, technical visit to the Diagnostic Laboratory of Cultural Heritage in Spoleto

Tuesday, July 22 – Todi: we will address the theme of the renovation and consolidation of existing buildings and urban regeneration after the earthquake. Following, technical visit to T2D Poroton.

Wednesday, July 23 – Assisi, INTERNATIONAL WATER CONFERENCE: SISTER WATER - Hall of Conciliation: we will discuss strategies for adaptation to climate change and civil protection strategies in the management of waters. Following, short round table and then guided tour of Assisi.

Thursday, July 24 - Orvieto: we will address the theme of flood risk and water management. Following, visit of the Dam of Corbara and the Baschi hydroelectric plant.

Friday, July 25 - Orvieto: we will address the theme of adaptive management of water resources in the era of climate change. Following, we will again deal with protection and enhancement of cultural assets with a visit to the Etruscan Necropolis of Crocefisso del Tufo.

Saturday, July 26 - Terni: visit to the Water Museum UNESCO and the Marmore Waterfall. Following there will be the closing ceremony with presentation of the participation diplomas at the Municipality of Todi.

Sunday, July 27 - Todi: return home of the participants
